

Gas Pressure Check Policy

Effective January 2009

New policy and procedures for gas line pressure checks:

Any gas customer having services turned off for any reason will be required to obtain a pressure check in order to have their gas services reinstated.

Option1: The town will provide the service of the pressure check for a fee of \$60.00 which will entitle the customer to a pressure check and one additional pressure check if the first shows that repairs need to be made on either side. If there is a third visit required an additional fee of \$60.00 will be charged for an additional two visits.

Optional 2: You may contract a licensed plumber, at your own expense, to place a pressure check on your gas line and an employee of the Town of Kentwood will verify that the pressure check has held. The plumber must sign off on the Gas work order at the time of verification and a copy of his or her license must be on file at City Hall and or a copy must be provided at the time of verification of the pressure check or the pressure check will not be acceptable.
